About the Woodland Opera House Guild

The Woodland Opera House Guild is a nonprofit, community based, volunteer service organization. We are dedicated to the promotion of the performing arts through our organization's support of the Woodland Opera House and its mission.

The Woodland Opera House (WOH) is one of the smallest state parks in the California Park system and a designated historical landmark. WOH is completely self-funding through performance income, grants, and donations, and receives no federal or state assistance.

The brick building, rebuilt in 1896 after being destroyed in a fire that burned most of the downtown, is a beautiful asset to the City of Woodland and the entire Sacramento Valley region. After standing vacant for almost 70 years, it was reopened in 1989.

The Guild was founded at the time of reopening by a group of dedicated volunteers committed to ensuring the ongoing operations of the WOH. The Guild's mission was established to provide the necessary support services that the WOH requires for its success. We do this by providing WOH volunteers for operations and productions, and through monies raised primarily through membership dues, concessions sales, and various fundraising events.



Benefits of Guild Membership

Guild members can see performances and concerts for free while ushering. They are recognized with an appreciation reception, and recognition at the annual Chesley Awards. Members may also attend special local events for free by helping promote the Guild and the Woodland Opera House. Membership is a wonderful opportunity for families and friends to enjoy a night out at the theatre. And of course, there is the good feeling of supporting our fabulous historic Woodland Opera House!

MEMBERSHIP

There are two categories of Guild Membership: Active and Associate.

ACTIVE members are at least 16 years old and are involved in an on-going service capacity, the primary activity being ushering at our many performances, concerts, and other special events. Active members are requested to help at least 6 times a year. Children ages 12-15 may join when they are sponsored and accompanied by an adult member. The Guild also offers a discounted family membership for four or more living at the same address.

ASSOCIATE members are not required to work, but their services are always welcome. They may sign up to volunteer for any event, performance or concert as they wish.

Guild members are one of the primary contacts with Opera House patrons. They enhance our guest's experience while attending the WOH by providing service in the areas of ushering for performances and concerts, selling concessions, giving tours, acting as docents for special events held at the Opera House, and assisting at fundraising events.
