



**Woodland Opera House COVID-19 Health and Safety Policy for our Theatre and Dance Annex  
Effective 9-27-2021**

The Woodland Opera House is committed to making certain everyone involved with the production of a show feels they are in a safe and healthy environment. To help achieve that goal, the Woodland Opera House is implementing the following policy and guidelines for our Theatre and Dance Annex (TADA).

**General**

All visitors, students, and staff inside of TADA must wear a mask due to current state and county guidelines. This is regardless of vaccination status. This applies to anyone within any Woodland Opera House facility.

Also be advised that:

- Masks will be provided at no cost if needed.
- Dance studios will be cleaned in between each class.
- Everyone is encouraged to use the available hand sanitizers.
- If you are ill or not feeling well, stay home and do not attend class.
- Everyone must observe all applicable current local, state, and federal guidelines.
- No sharing of water bottles or snacks.

**Lobby**

Our lobby will be closed to all except for staff and students. Parents with payments or questions may make an appointment or visit us during lobby hours: 4:00-7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday or 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 noon on Saturdays. Masks must be worn, and we ask that if you feel ill or are experiencing any cold, flu, or COVID symptoms that you please stay home and call or email us with your questions. **COVID Policies**

Once TADA is notified of a confirmed positive case of COVID-19 at our facility, the following steps are followed:

- Individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 are contacted and advised of quarantine periods.
- TADA staff perform contact tracing activities to determine close contacts. \*
- Close contacts who are not fully vaccinated are contacted and informed of their need to quarantine and the return to work or class date.
- Communications are prepared and sent to the following groups:
  - Staff, students, and/or parents/guardians of students who have had close contact with the positive case.
- Case and contact tracing information are reported to the Yolo County Health Department.
- Affected areas are cleaned and treated.

\*Close contact is defined as any individual who was within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes up to 48 hours from the start of COVID-19 symptoms or up to 48 hours from the testing date if the infected person was without symptoms prior to testing.

If a student has been exposed outside of TADA, or shows any symptoms of COVID, please follow these guidelines:

- Notify TADA staff of a possible exposure and do not attend class.
- Student should receive a COVID-19 test to verify exposure:

·If negative, students may return to class upon proof of a negative COVID-19 test.

·If positive, students must remain home for a 10-day period from the date of the first symptom or positive COVID-19 test.

With the changing dynamics of the pandemic, the WOH will follow the COVID-19 guidelines and policies from the Center for Disease Control, the State of California, Yolo County, and the City of Woodland. The Woodland Opera House will monitor these modifications and this policy may be updated and adjusted from time to time.
